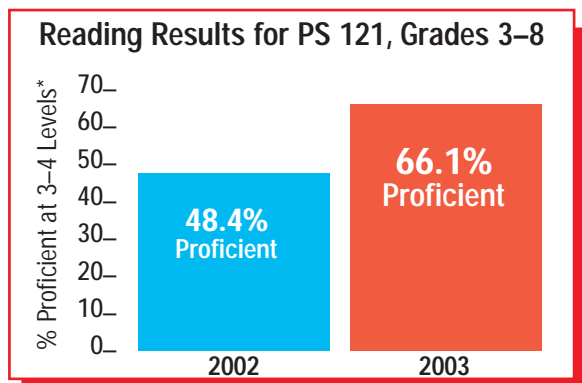
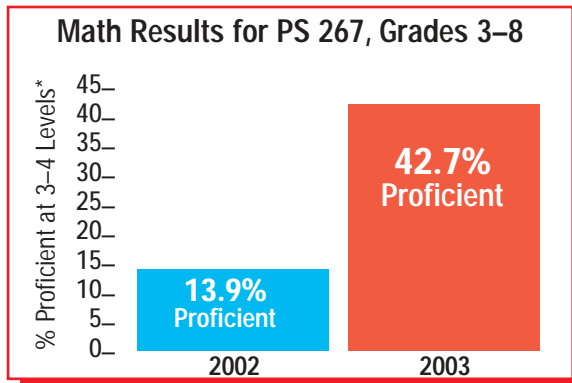


Research-based Success for Reading and Math

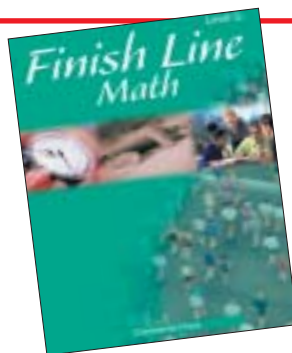
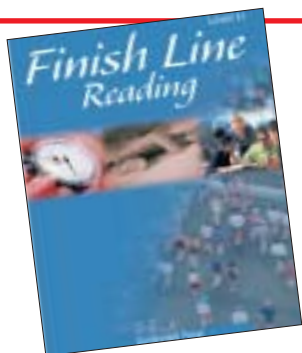
